Objective: These one day training workshops will provide the opportunity to learn from a team of experts how to recognize, diagnose, and manage canola production practices.

Four Groups Rotating Through Eight Concurrent Stations:

- #1 The Future is Now sprayer technology, nozzle technology and equipment residue.
- #2 Send It on Down seed placed fertilizer and soil.
- #3 Ultimate Canola look at how an extra \$10/acre could be spent on canola production.
- **#4 What's in Your Sweep Net?** identifying canola pests and beneficial insects, including Swede midge. Learn about lygus bug staging and determining economic thresholds.
- #5 Ice, Ice, Baby assessing the degree of frost damage to canola plants.
- #6 Clubroot cause, effects and management.
- #7 We've Only Just Begun identifying factors in low plant stand establishments.
- **#8 High Hopes** evaluating the sclerotinia risk in canola just before and after the bolting stage. Look at nutrient deficiencies and assess for top dressing.
