

## **XXIII SUMMARY**

The Canola Production Centre program is a continuing success in spite of many environmental challenges. These include spring frost, hail, flooding, drought and insect damage. In 2001, the program looked not only at new agronomic issues and management techniques brought forward to us by producers and industry, but ongoing trials. Examples of new trials include; seed bulking, harvest management, time of burnoff and optimizing canola production. Examples of ongoing trials include; variety evaluation, canopy manipulation, cabbage seedpod weevil and systems comparison trials. These trials were carried out in a non-biased, in depth, quality driven fashion that the Canola Council of Canada strives for. The information outlined in this report should be used as a part of a complete information gathering process to assist producers in making decisions on their farms.
