SAFETY MARGINS:

SAFETY MARGINS MEASURED FROM TRIM SIZE:

.375" for spreads from gutter, .625" sides and .375" top and bottom; for full page ads .625" sides and .375" top and bottom.

HALFTONE LINE SCREEN:

175 lpi

DOT GAIN:

10% on SWOP coated

PRINTING:

Heat-set web offset

BINDING:

saddle-stitched

PRODUCTION SPECIFICATIONS:

All supplied art must be in pdf format, with all elements converted to CMYK and a minimum resolution of 300 dpi. We do not accept ads in Microsoft Word format. All files will be reviewed to ensure they meet pre-press standards. Clients will be contacted regarding any modifications required.

FINE LINE WORK AND LETTERING:

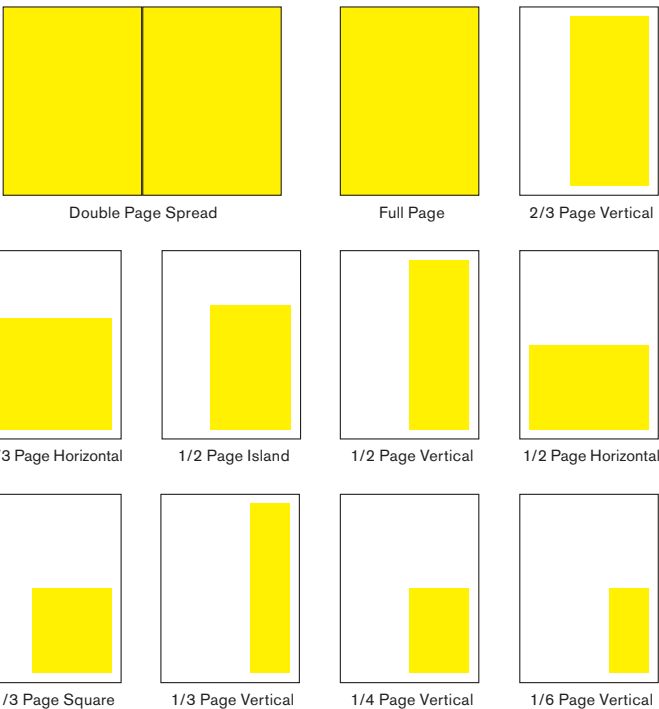
Fine serifs, small lettering and thin line work should be restricted to one color and preferably not smaller than 7 point. The use of small letter (under 7 points) and fine serifs should be avoided.

INK DENSITY:

Adjust ink limit in photos and rich blacks so that total coverage does not exceed 280%.
