## AGENDA

**Objective:** These one day training workshops will provide the opportunity to learn from a team of experts how to recognize, diagnose, and manage canola production practices.

Four Groups Rotating Through Eight Concurrent Stations:

- **#1 - The Future is Now** – sprayer technology, nozzle technology and equipment residue.
- **#2 - Send It on Down** – seed placed fertilizer and soil.
- **#3 - Ultimate Canola** – look at how an extra \$10/acre could be spent on canola production.
- **#4 - What's in Your Sweep Net?** – identifying canola pests and beneficial insects, including Swede midge. Learn about lygus bug staging and determining economic thresholds.
- **#5 - Ice, Ice, Baby** – assessing the degree of frost damage to canola plants.
- **#6 - Clubroot** – cause, effects and management.
- **#7 - We've Only Just Begun** – identifying factors in low plant stand establishments.
- **#8 - High Hopes** – evaluating the sclerotinia risk in canola just before and after the bolting stage. Look at nutrient deficiencies and assess for top dressing.
