#### **HOW TO PLAY**

1. TO PLAY: Commencing on or about October 8, 2025, pre-registered full delegates attending the 2026 Canadian Crops Convention at The Westin Harbour Castle, 1 Harbour Sq., Toronto Ontario, will be automatically entered into the promotional contest. The contest will close to all participants by January 15, 2026, at 11:59 pm CST. The promotional draw will be held over staggered dates (reference Table 1). ### GENERAL RULES
